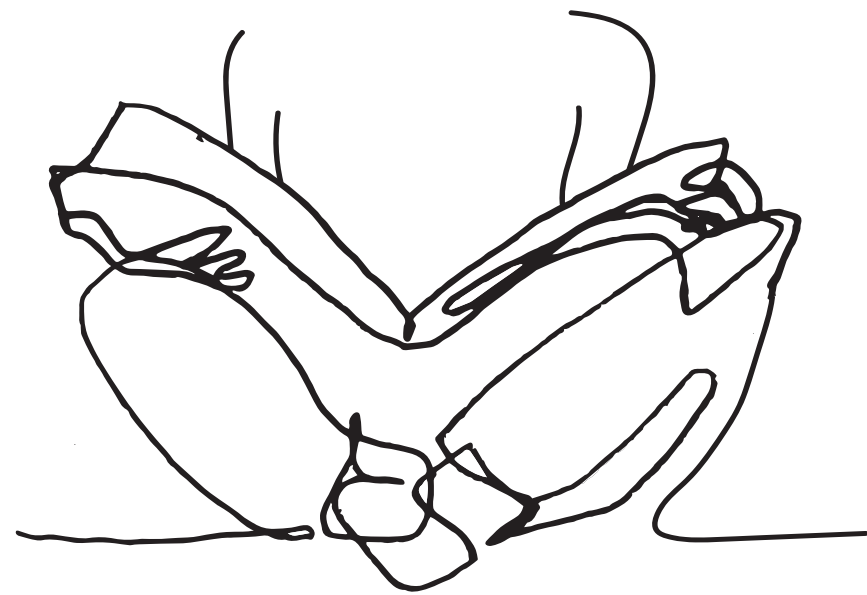

## HOW TO MAKE THE MOST OF THIS READING PLAN

This resource was created to fuel your passion for the Bible and prayer. Whether you've walked with Jesus 30 years or 30 days, this plan will deepen your love for God and His Word. As you apply this to your daily time with God, your love for His presence and confidence in hearing His voice will increase. There's no magic in these pages, just a firm belief that our faithful Father loves to meet with and speak to His children. Approach this plan with a heart open and ready to encounter Jesus in a new and deeper way.

The plan is broken up into four weeks. Each day has two parts. Part One focuses on Scripture. In this section you'll find a Bible passage to read and questions for reflection and journaling. As you invite the Holy Spirit to be your guide, this section will help uncover the brilliance hidden within the Bible.

Part Two focuses on prayer. Here you'll find Bible passages, practical prayer focuses and godly confessions that will strengthen and sharpen your prayer time.

Each part was created with intention. The following pages are a description of how to get the most out of each one.



# PART 01

## THE SCRIPTURE

### SOW

#### SYSTEMATIC READING

This practice allows you to read through one book of the Bible over a period of time. With this plan, you will read through the Book of Mark systematically over the course of four weeks. Each week, on Day 1, Day 3 and Day 5, you will read a passage from the Gospel of Mark. The pace gives you time to read slowly, and the plan provides some reflection questions for you to respond to in your journal.

#### ONE TOPIC STUDY

The second practice guides you through a specific topic. Each week has one topic, and on Day 2 and Day 4 you will be immersing yourself in verses about that subject. The goal is to begin to deepen an understanding of God's truth surrounding that topic. As revelation begins to unfold in your heart, you will find your life being transformed by truth. This practice also allows for slow reading with reflection and journaling. All these topical verses are from the ESV translation.

#### WAITING AND REPEATING

This third practice will appear weekly on Day 6 and Day 7. This involves discovering a verse or brief passage that shimmers or stands out to you. You'll take the time to "walk around it," memorize it, pray it and worship God for the truth contained in it. Like the other two practices, you must invite the Holy Spirit to be your teacher and guide. Then expect the eternal and imperishable Word of God to change you from the inside out. This section also provides an opportunity for you to linger and wait on the Lord and respond in your own unique fashion.

# PART 02

## PRAYER

### dig

#### DEMONSTRATE YOUR LOVE

Scripture tells us to approach God with thanksgiving and praise. Demonstrating your love for God is one of the best ways to recalibrate your heart toward Him. This section provides Bible passages you can use as a springboard to worship. Don't wait until you feel it. Use your words and your body posture to worship and it will stir your spirit. Sing a song, lift your hands, make a list of things you are thankful for and speak them out one by one.

#### INTERCESSION AND REQUESTS

After worship, intercede for the needs of life. Jesus taught us to pray, "Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven." This is not primarily a passive prayer of submission, but a contending prayer of divine partnership. God partners with His children, asking us to pray His will on the earth. Day 1 through 5 begins big and ends narrow. You will pray for a nation, leaders and government, the people in your life and your own needs. Day 6 and 7 focuses on people you know and your own needs.

#### GODLY CONFESSION

This third portion of your prayer time includes two types of confession. First, confession of any known sin followed by receiving God's complete forgiveness. Next, confession of who you are in God. There are over 7,000 promises in the Bible and every one of them belongs to those who belong to Christ. These confessions have a profound impact on your emotional and mental health. Confessions speak to the invisible world around you and change the atmosphere. This section provides those confessions for you, so by the end of the month you will have 28 statements of faith about who you are in Christ.

PART ONE. SOW/SYSTEMATIC READING:  
THE GOSPEL OF MARK (40 MIN)

## READING PASSAGE: MARK 1

### QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION AND JOURNALING

1. There's a lot of action in these 45 verses. What story or event seems to be drawing your attention?  
Reread that portion of scripture slowly.
2. What statement or phrase is the Holy Spirit highlighting to you? Write this down in your journal.
3. How should you respond to what stood out to you? How does this impact your personal walk with Christ?



PART TWO. DIG/PRAYER (20 MIN)

### DEMONSTRATE YOUR LOVE:

Read 1 Chronicles 16:23-25. Use these verses as a springboard to begin demonstrating your love for God through worship. Raise your voice, use your hands, posture yourself and sing a song in worship to God.

### INTERCESSION AND REQUESTS:

\* The Nation of North Korea: growth of the Church, strength for persecuted Christians, and God's kingdom and justice to come to this land

*Matthew 5:44*

But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you

*Hebrews 13:3*

Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them, and those who are mistreated, since you also are in the body.

\* Our President: salvation, wisdom, protection

*1 Timothy 2:1-4*

First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.



\* Your family members: salvation, healing, freedom from sin and any other known needs

*Luke 10:19*

Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you.

*Acts 16:14b*

...The Lord opened her heart to pay attention to what was said by Paul.

\* Bring your own needs before God

*Philippians 4:19*

And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

*3 John 2*

Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, as it goes well with your soul.

### **GODLY CONFESSIONS:**

As you begin to wrap up your time with God, is there any unconfessed sin you sense the Holy Spirit bringing to your attention? 1 John 1:9 tells us that if we confess our sins, God is faithful and just to forgive us and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Take a few moments and respond to what His Spirit is showing you.

Take the last few moments and speak this confession of faith out loud several times:

# 02

## PART ONE. SOW/ONE TOPIC STUDY: IN CHRIST (40 MIN)

During this week's topical study, we will be approaching the topic of the life and freedom you have in Christ. Look up each of the following scriptures. Take your time and read the verses slowly. Then read them again, slowly and out loud. Allow the truth of these verses to sink deep into your soul.

Verses to reflect upon today: Ephesians 2:13, 2 Corinthians 5:17, 1 Corinthians 1:30, 2 Corinthians 2:14, Ephesians 4:32.

After each verse or passage, consider the following questions. Respond in your journal as God speaks to you.

\* What life-transforming benefits do you see in these verses that apply to your everyday life? List every blessing and benefit you find that are yours in Christ.

\* How does God want to work through your life as a result of 'being in Christ'? Write down the ways you can practically live out this 'in Christ' life with your family and friends.

## PART TWO. DIG/PRAYER (20 MIN)

**DEMONSTRATE YOUR LOVE:**

Based on the scriptures you just read about your life in Christ, write a prayer of thanksgiving and gratitude to God for all He has done for you. Read this prayer out loud. Sing your grateful prayer to God! Worship Him with your whole heart.

**INTERCESSION AND REQUESTS:**

\* The Nation of Mexico: availability of Bibles and increase of discipleship materials, strength for persecuted Christians, government officials to come to know Christ

*\* Acts 2:46-47*

And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.

\* Leaders and authorities in your city: the mayor, city council, police chief, school board: salvation, righteousness and justice to prevail

*1 Timothy 2:1-4*

First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

\* Your friends: to know Christ, free from oppression (addiction, fear, illness, etc.)

*Psalm 98:2*

The Lord has made known His salvation; He has revealed His righteousness in the sight of the nations.

*Matthew 8:16-17*

That evening they brought to Him many who were oppressed by demons, and He cast out the spirits with a word and healed all who were sick. This was to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah: "He took our illnesses and bore our diseases."

\* Bring your own needs before God

*2 Thessalonians 2:16-17*

Now may our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God our Father, who loved us and gave us eternal comfort and good hope through grace, comfort your hearts and establish them in every good work and word.

**GODLY CONFESSIONS:**

From your reading and prayer, has God shown you any heart attitude or behavior that is not pleasing to Him? Take a few moments to confess your sin and receive His full forgiveness.

Now it's time to speak out these faith confessions over your own soul. Say them out loud several times - let them sink in. Begin to commit these to memory.

## 03

PART ONE. SOW/SYSTEMATIC READING:  
THE GOSPEL OF MARK (40 MIN)

**READING PASSAGE: MARK 2 AND 3**  
QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION AND JOURNALING

1. There are many interactions between Jesus and others in these two chapters. Which particular one is the Holy Spirit leading you to focus on? Take the time to reread that passage a few more times.
2. What should you do about what stood out to you in these verses? By faith, receive what God is speaking to you. Journal how this influences your spiritual journey right now. How does it affect your relationships?

PART TWO. DIG/PRAYER (20 MIN)

**DEMONSTRATE YOUR LOVE:**

Read Psalm 100. Approach your heavenly father with an honest and grateful heart. Be yourself! Tell Him how much you love Him. If you pray in tongues, take some time and use your spiritual language to praise God.

**INTERCESSION AND REQUESTS:**

- \* The Nation of Sudan: peace and reconciliation among all people groups, righteous government, wisdom for Christians to evangelize

*Psalm 22:27-28*

All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the Lord, and all the families of the nations shall worship before you. For kingship belongs to the Lord, and He rules over the nations.

- \* The local Church in your city: spiritual awakening and growth

*Ephesians 4:11-13*

And He gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.

- \* Your co-workers: that God would draw them to salvation, physical healing

*John 14:6*

Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.'

\* Bring your own needs before God

*John 14:12-14*

"Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father. Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it.

### **GODLY CONFESSIONS:**

Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal any areas of disobedience toward God. Confess as He reveals anything to you. Raise your hands toward heaven and receive complete forgiveness and cleansing from God. Then, receive strength to walk in surrender in this area.

Our faith confessions are growing! Don't underestimate the power of speaking truth over your own life. In faith, declare these statements five times out loud right now.

# 04

PART ONE. SOW/ONE TOPIC STUDY:

## **IN CHRIST (40 MIN)**

Today, take your time and meditate on the truth of the glorious life you have in Christ.

Look up each of the following scriptures and read them slowly several times. Let the truth of God's Word settle in your soul.

Verses to reflect upon today: Romans 6:11, Romans 8:1, Galatians 3:25-26, Ephesians 2:10, 2 Timothy 1:8-9

After each verse or passage, consider the following questions. Respond in your journal as God speaks to you.

\* According to these verses, how has your life changed since you surrendered to Christ? Journal what you sense God saying to you.

\* Use the verses you just read to write as many "I am" statements as possible. For example: "*I am a child of God through faith.*" These statements will reflect all that God has done for you 'in Christ.'

## PART TWO. DIG/PRAYER (20 MIN)

**DEMONSTRATE YOUR LOVE:**

Read Psalm 18:1-3. With all your heart and soul, worship God! Make a list of what you are thankful for. Use it as a song to praise Jesus! Stand, kneel, dance, lift your hands with abandon to the God who is worthy of all praise! End this time with surrender. Give Him every part of your life.

**INTERCESSION AND REQUESTS:**

\* The Nation of Columbia: that the Christian Church would be filled with the power of the Holy Spirit

*Acts 5:12-16*

Now many signs and wonders were regularly done among the people by the hands of the apostles. And they were all together in Solomon's Portico. None of the rest dared join them, but the people held them in high esteem. And more than ever believers were added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, so that they even carried out the sick into the streets and laid them on cots and mats, that as Peter came by at least his shadow might fall on some of them. The people also gathered from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing the sick and those afflicted with unclean spirits, and they were all healed.

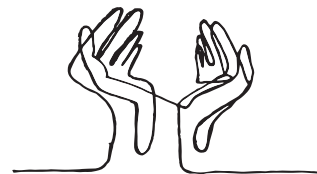
\* The welfare of your city:

*Jeremiah 29:7*

But seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the Lord on its behalf, for in its welfare you will find your welfare.

*Proverbs 11:11*

By the blessing of the upright a city is exalted, but by the mouth of the wicked it is overthrown stature of the fullness of Christ.



\* Your neighbors: they would be drawn to Jesus by your life

*2 Corinthians 2:14-15*

But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of Him everywhere. For we are the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing,

\* Bring your own needs before God

*Hebrews 4:16*

Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

**GODLY CONFESSIONS:**

Are you struggling with anxiety, fear, frustration, disappointment - or anything that is hindering your life of faith and joy in Christ? Take a few moments and release those struggles. Confess any sin you sense may be hiding in your heart. Take a deep breath and receive the love and forgiveness found freely in Christ.

It's time to speak out these incredible truths over your life. Saying them out loud strengthens their power. Let them change the atmosphere!

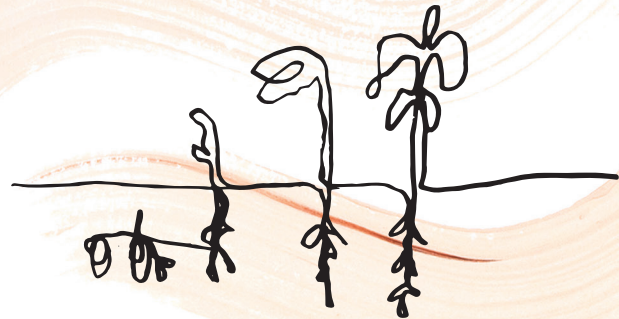

2. What is God saying to you personally through this? Write out how you will respond to His voice this week.



PART TWO. DIG/PRAYER (20 MIN)

### DEMONSTRATE YOUR LOVE:

Read Psalm 145 out loud. Then, begin to praise God in your own words, from an honest and authentic heart! Posture your body in worship and allow this to stir your spirit.

### INTERCESSION AND REQUESTS:

- \* The Nation of Somalia: strength, boldness and protection for persecuted Christians.

*Psalm 3:1-3*

O Lord, how many are my foes! Many are rising against me; many are saying of my soul, "There is no salvation for him in God." Selah. But you, O Lord, are a shield about me, my glory, and the lifter of my head.

- \* Transformation of your city: crime and poverty reduced, gospel would advance in every sphere of influence

*2 Chronicles 7:14*

If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

- \* Schools in your neighborhood: protection, an end to school violence

*Psalm 91:1-2*

He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say to the Lord, "My refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

\* Bring your own needs before God

*Matthew 7:7-9*

"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. Or which one of you, if his son asks him for bread, will give him a stone?"

### **GODLY CONFESSIONS:**

Today remember the power of speaking God's Word and truth over your soul. Before you confess these truths, quiet your heart and position yourself in faith. The faith that rests in the incredible and everlasting love of the Father for you.

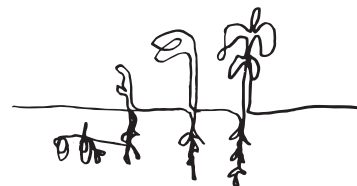

# 06

PART ONE. SOW/WAITING & REPEATING (40 MIN)

As you approach the scripture for today be ready to linger. Be ready to read, to wait and to 'walk around' the verses. Waiting on the Lord brings deeper revelation and renews our strength. After you read the passage, there are some suggested ways to discover and apply what God is speaking to you. Don't rush. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you as you wait and repeat.

### **TODAY'S PASSAGE: ISAIAH 40:27-31**

- \* Choose one verse that stands out and memorize it.
- \* Pray an honest and personal prayer based on this passage.
- \* Compose a song of praise using some of these verses. Sing that song to the Lord.
- \* Use your own words to write a poem that expresses hope from a portion of this passage.

## PART TWO. DIG/PRAYER (20 MIN)

**DEMONSTRATE YOUR LOVE:**

Praise God with your whole being as you listen to two or three of your favorite worship songs.

**INTERCESSION AND REQUESTS:**

Over these next two days, we are asking God to show us some specific people He wants us to intercede for. Ask in faith and trust Him as He speaks to you. Honor this call to intercede by not sharing what He's showing you with anyone else. Pray in secret, and let God do His glorious work.

\* *A family in need:* As God brings a family to mind, begin by blessing their marriage and their children. Pray that their love and commitment to one another would grow deeper and stronger. Pray for the Holy Spirit to fill their home with peace, love, forgiveness, joy and life. Ask God to provide for every financial need they have. Pray protection over their health, relationships and home.

\* *Church leaders:* Pray for your Campus Pastor and other key leaders within your church community. Ask God to reveal more and more of His love to them, and to strengthen their relationship with Christ. Pray protection over their hearts and minds, over their families and over the ministry God has entrusted to them. Speak blessing over them!

\* *Your enemies:* Still your heart before the Lord and begin to pray for those who have hurt you. It could be a small, minor offense or a deep wound. Release them with forgiveness and begin to ask God to bless them. Pray that He would reveal His love to them. Pray that He would pour out His grace and mercy upon their lives.

\* *Your own specific needs:* Ask God for your current needs. He wants you to ask and keep asking.

**GODLY CONFESSIONS:**

As you quietly reflect over the past few days, is there any word or deed that God is showing you that you need to confess? If so, do just that and receive the liberating freedom that comes from full forgiveness and cleansing in Jesus.

The list is getting longer and more powerful. Speak these truths out loud in faith!

## PART TWO. DIG/PRAYER (20 MIN)

## DEMONSTRATE YOUR LOVE:

Read Ephesians 5:20. Begin to thank God for everything He has done for you. Don't hold back. Then move into a time of worship and praise. Stand. Raise your hands. Sing a song to Him.

## INTERCESSION AND REQUESTS:

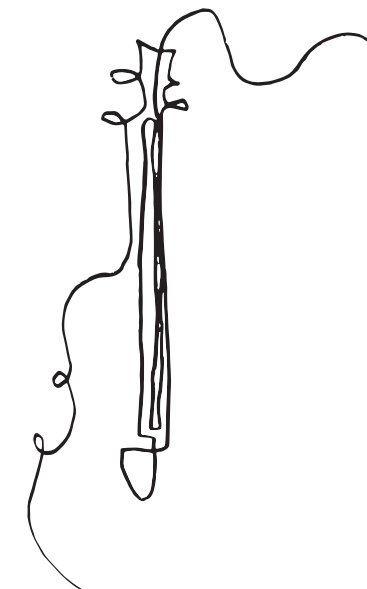
Take some time and pray again for the people God brought to mind yesterday. Thank God for the work He is doing in their lives. Then, ask Him if there's anything He'd like you to do as well. It could be a word of encouragement, an anonymous gift or act of service. Write down what He shows you and then obey Him.

\* *A family in need*

\* *Church leaders*

\* *Your enemies*

\* *Your own needs*



**GODLY CONFESSIONS:**

Looking back at the week, is there any area where you lacked showing love to someone? If so, take a moment to confess that to Jesus. Receive His forgiveness and let the Holy Spirit pour out His love into your heart.

After you read these seven statements out loud over your soul, take them and put them somewhere so you will come across them during the day. Don't limit your confession to just this time with God. Begin to confess these truths during your lunch or your commute home. There is power in our words!

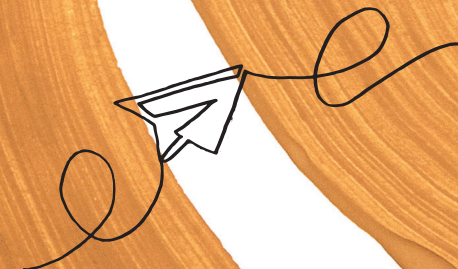

But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you

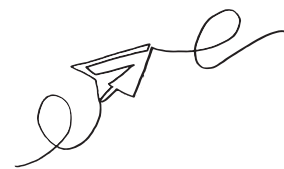

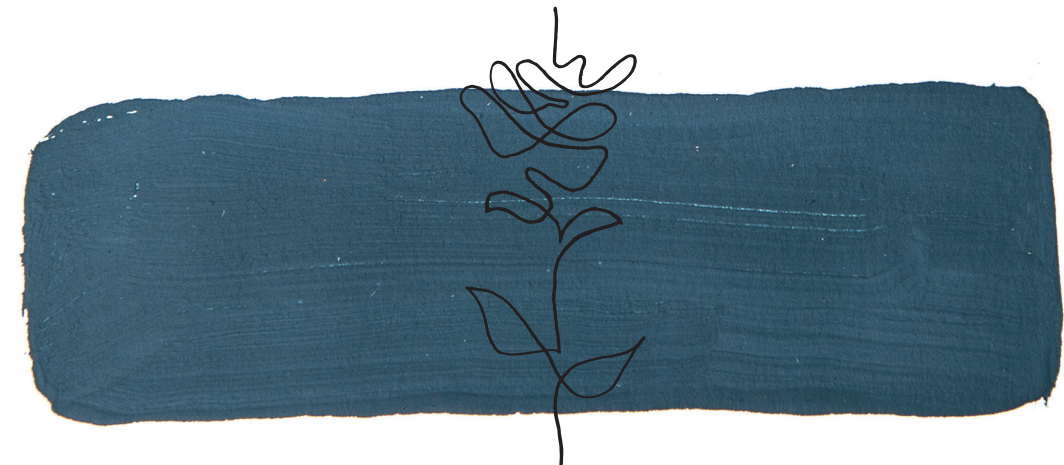

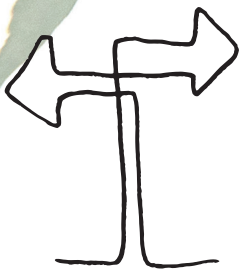

## PART TWO. DIG/PRAYER (20 MIN)

### DEMONSTRATE YOUR LOVE:

Read Revelation 5:9-10. Take some time to worship with a spirit of reverence and holiness. Posture your physical body in way that expresses your awe for God. This could be bowing, kneeling or even laying down before Him. Pour out your heart of devotion to him. He is worthy!

### INTERCESSION AND REQUESTS:

Your time of prayer these next two days will focus on people in your life. You will be asking God to show you exactly who He desires you to pray for. Trust Him to reveal His heart for them. Journal what He is showing you and your prayers for them. Again, pray in secret knowing your heavenly father sees you and will work on behalf of those you intercede for. Don't forget to pray for your specific needs at the end.

\* *A difficult co-worker or classmate:* Ask God to show you someone that you might avoid or someone who is not easy to work with. Begin to intercede for that person by name. If you're not sure how to pray, this is a good time to use the gift of tongues. We don't always see the inner brokenness in someone. Allow God to soften your heart and get past your own struggle with them. Pray for salvation, healing, wholeness, blessing. Whatever God shows you. Find a scripture and speak it over their life.

\* *A local church you don't attend:* Ask God to bless the pastors and leaders and to give them wisdom, pray for spiritual awakening and growth, pray for financial provision and that God would use them in your city.

\* *A single parent that you know:* Ask God to show you a single parent that needs support in prayer. Pray for strength, grace, provision and peace for that mom or dad who is doing the job of two. Pray for wisdom for how to raise their kids.

\* *Your own specific needs:* Ask God for your current needs. He wants you to ask and keep asking. Don't neglect to seek Him for each area of your life.



**GODLY CONFESSIONS:**

Is there anyone you are struggling to forgive or love freely? Ask the Holy Spirit to show you. Scripture tells us to forgive others as Christ forgave us. That means He empowers us to do that. Sometimes it's one prayer, and sometimes it takes many. God honors our humility and faith. If there is someone that comes to mind, simply confess your unforgiveness or lack of love and receive God's forgiveness. Ask the Holy Spirit to fill your heart with the grace needed to walk free in this area.

Time to declare these powerful confessions of faith. Say them like you believe them. They are truth!

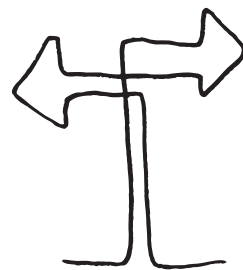

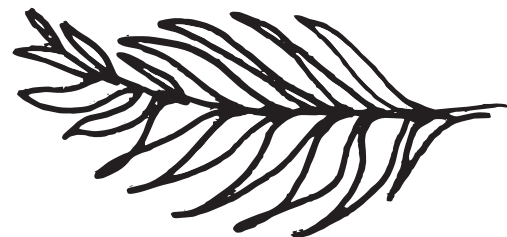

Ask God to increase his or her revelation of His love for them and that they would fulfill every good purpose God has for their lives.

\* *Two teenagers in your life:* Allow God to bring two teens to mind and then intercede on their behalf. Pray for them to fully know and trust Christ. Pray that they would be able to resist peer pressure and instead radically live for Jesus. Pray that God would send them godly mentors and friends to walk daily with them. Pray for a hunger for the Bible and knowing Jesus.

\* *Your boss or supervisor at work:* Before praying, posture your heart in grace, mercy and forgiveness towards him or her. Pray for them to come to know Christ or grow in their relationship with Him. Pray for any known needs; his or her family, health, etc. Then pray as God leads you.

\* *Your own specific needs:* Don't rush over this. It's vital that you are bringing your own personal needs before God. He tells us to ask and to receive.

**GODLY CONFESSIONS:**

Take a moment to reflect on your interactions with your family and friends. Have you loved and served them well? As the Lord leads, confess any times you were unloving or selfish. Allow Him to forgive, cleanse and free you from these sins. Let His joy fill your heart.

Your collection of faith confessions continues to grow. Let these truths fill you with assurance of your new life in Jesus.

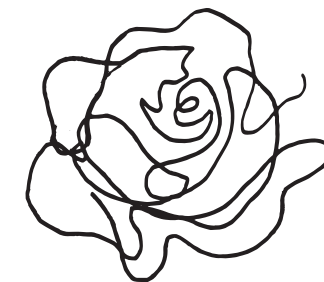

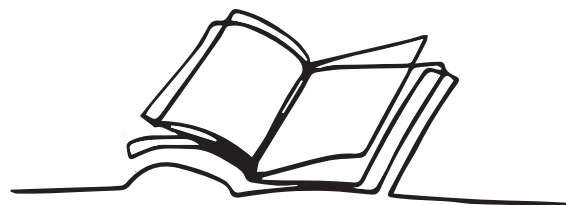

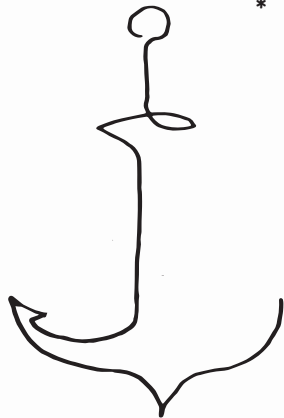

Invite the Holy Spirit into your time of Bible reading. Expect Him to guide you into greater truth as you meditate on the following verses. Read and reread slowly and out loud, listening for what God wants to reveal to you today. Don't rush this sacred process.

## TODAY'S PASSAGE: JEREMIAH 29:11-13

- \* Choose one verse that stands out and memorize it.
- \* Pray an honest and personal prayer based on this passage.
- \* Compose a song of praise using some of these verses. Sing that song to the Lord.
- \* Use your own words to write a poem that expresses hope from a portion of this passage.



## PART TWO. DIG/PRAYER (20 MIN)

## DEMONSTRATE YOUR LOVE:

Using two or three of your favorite worship songs, praise the Lord with all your heart and strength. Stand, raise your hands - truly demonstrate how much you love Him.

## INTERCESSION AND REQUESTS:

As you focus the next two days on specific people in your life, trust the Lord to show you who to pray for. Believe that He will lead you to pray according to His will for them. As you pray in secret, trust God to do what only He can do. Don't forget to pray for your specific needs at the end.

\* *Your closest family member who is far from God:* Scripture tells us that it is God's will for all to come to know Him and be saved. Pray with confidence, asking the Father to draw your loved one. Take authority over the evil influences that are blinding their eyes to the gospel. Ask God, who is rich in mercy, to bring your family member to a saving knowledge of the gospel.

\* *Someone you interact with regularly:* This could be your barista, a person at your gym, your hairdresser or barber or the UPS guy. Pray for an opportunity to share the love of Christ with them. Pray that their hearts would be open to the gospel.

\* *Someone you know who is battling a physical illness:* Ask God to heal that person. Pray against discouragement, guilt, shame, frustration and anger. Pray for wisdom for any doctors involved in their care. Pray for a spirit of compassion and understanding for their family members.

\* *Your own specific needs:* Ask God for your current needs. He wants you to ask and keep asking. Don't neglect to seek Him for each area of your life.

**GODLY CONFESSIONS:**

As you end this week, ask the Holy Spirit to show you any times you failed to love others well. Confess this to the Lord and receive forgiveness. Open your heart and receive more of the love of God.

Confess these statements boldly over your life knowing that they are impacting your soul!

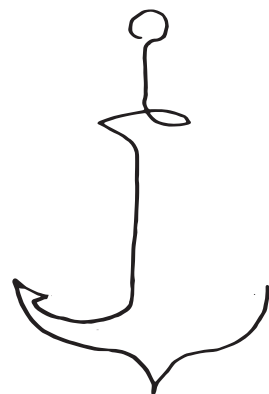

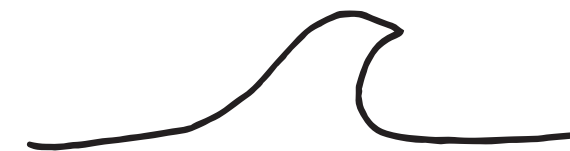

**28****PART ONE. SOW/WAITING & REPEATING (40 MIN)**

Take the time to walk around the following verses. Wait on the voice of the Lord as He begins to speak His truth to your heart. He is a good Father who gives good gifts to his children.

## PART TWO. DIG/PRAYER (20 MIN)

**DEMONSTRATE YOUR LOVE:**

The verses today spoke about the goodness and lovingkindness of our God appearing and saving us. Make a list of all the things you are grateful to God for. Turn your list into a song of praise and worship. Love Him with all your heart.

**INTERCESSION AND REQUESTS:**

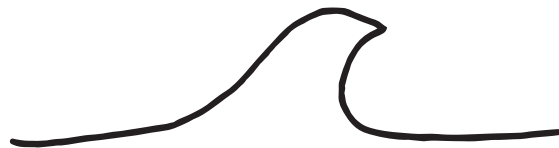
Continue to pray for the people revealed yesterday. Then ask Him how you can be a blessing to them. What practical way can you extend the love and mercy of God to each of them? Journal what He shows you and then take steps to obey Him. Be sure to end your prayer time praying for your own life. God cares about your needs.

**GODLY CONFESSIONS:**

Ask God to reveal any unconfessed sin in your life. Don't force this. God loves you and will show you gently and clearly. Confess and then receive His forgiveness, cleansing and joy.

Here is the last of your 28 faith confessions. Continue this practice by writing your own confessions from the truth found in Scripture. Don't neglect the daily practice of confessing all the blessings you have in Christ.
